

The Innova Fellowship 2023

The Innova [Africa Future of Work and Entrepreneurship] Fellowship is designed to equip young innovators across Africa to create research-driven solutions to solving employment challenges and enabling young Africans to thrive in the entrepreneurial future of work.

What is expected from you as a fellow

- *Conduct Research:* Selected fellows will conduct primary and secondary research in their countries to better understand the entrepreneurial future of work challenges and opportunities. This will include learning sessions covering self learning, peer learning and learning with experts and mentors.
- *Pilot or strengthen Innovative solutions:* Following the outcomes of research conducted, fellows will choose to deliver an innovative solution that either amplifies an effort of an existing solution that is tackling an identified problem or will come up with an entirely new solution.
- *Be a Country Partner:* Selected fellows will serve as in-country partners for the Africa Future of Work and Entrepreneurship Summit/Fellowship, highlighting its goals and values, spreading information about the program, finding/collaborating with partners and mobilizing toward the 2023 summit in Kigali

Application Process

We have an exciting application process. First, note that the applications are received and reviewed on a rolling basis, so, the earlier you send in a quality application, the higher the chances of being selected. All applications close on July 15 2023. Notifications will be done between the 17th and 21st July and the fellowship will officially kick off virtually on the 24th of July 2023.

To apply, you will need to make a simple presentation with the following details to be uploaded in PDF format on the application form:

Creative Presentation/Portfolio [PDF Document]

Put together a presentation about yourself answering the following 12 questions. Make it as creative as you can. You can include images, links, statistics/numbers, videos etc.

Do whatever makes it fun and rewarding for you.

1. Who are you?
2. What are your skills and strengths?
3. What is your personal mission and vision for impact?

4. How have you demonstrated leadership, teamwork and collaboration?
5. How have you demonstrated Pan-Africanism?
6. How have you demonstrated commitment to employability or job creation?
7. How have you demonstrated entrepreneurship?
8. What is your experience and work with Technology?
9. What experience do you have with conducting research?
10. What do you think the future of work in Africa will look like?
11. Why is the fellowship important to you and what you will do with your learning and exposure?
12. Why should you be selected for the fellowship?
